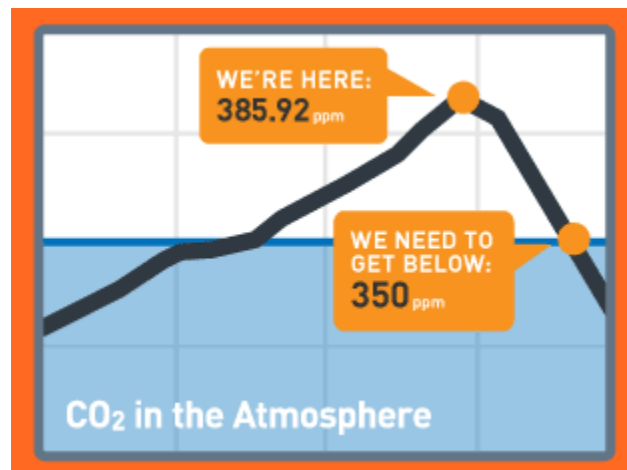


350 The MGC 350

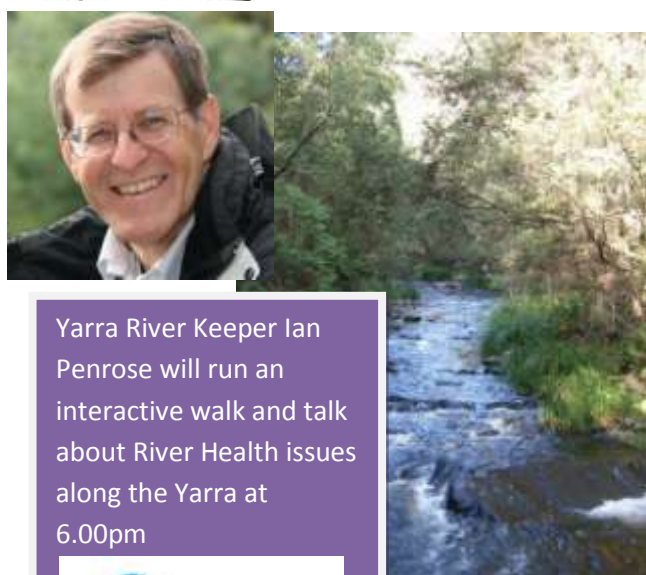
